2009 sees the 750th Anniversary of Camelford receiving its Royal Charter and C.A.R. is planning several events to mark this historic mile-stone.

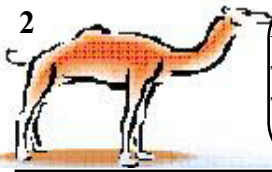
We hope to arrange festivities that will allow all residents to take part in the celebrations with specific attractions for the young, the not-so-young and all 'in-betweeners' !!

'Foyer' is designed to provide affordable accommodation for young people aged 16-25 with access to training while they seek employment and gain independence.

NCDC has worked with local organisations from the public, private and voluntary sectors to set up foyers and Camelford's foyer will be located in Fore St. (the old Labour Exchange building) and will provide accommodation for (we believe) six young people.

Digital switchover

Digital UK has launched an online guide and checklist for local authorities to help them prepare for digital TV switchover. It explains the issues councils and their strategic partners need to consider in the countdown to digital switchover: the implications for services such as schools, housing and social care; the need to protect consumers from mis-selling and rogue traders; and the implications for energy efficiency, waste disposal and planning.
